

OBJECTIVE



Water Framework Directive / EUWI JP

- Facilitate Development of sound water management practices in non-EU countries by using -where appropriate- the EU WFD principles
- Facilitate the implementation of the WFD in *EU countries* by using non EU experience and new solutions

- Nov. 2003: First ideas & discussions with African partners;
- June 2004: Presentation of the concept, EUWI-MSF;
- June 2004: Agreement on the process by the EU Water Directors;
- August 2004: MSF ~ Specific session on linkages WFD/EUWI;
 Stock
- Sept. 2004 : First Regional Process MED; Brindisi
- Dec. 2004 : Endorsement of the global strategy and Agreement on the 2005 MED activities by the EU Water Directors


